

RARE BOOK POLICY

What is a rare book?

Rare books are determined by their importance, edition, and age. Artist-made, out-of-print, and delicate books are rare. RARE BOOKS DO NOT CIRCULATE.

How can I look at a rare book?

First, ask a Reference Librarian to get the book out. You can have 2 at a time.

Then, take the book to the circulation desk to have it checked out under your account.

How long can I have a rare book?

You can have a rare book for 2 hours in the Library. Please return the book to the circulation desk. If the book is returned late, a fee will appear on your account.
